The International African Energy, Oil and Gas Summit (IAEOGS) 2026 returns for its 5th Edition, convening in Qatar as a Luxury Edition of Africa's foremost energy investment and policy platform.

IAEOGS 2026 is organised by International Energy Summit Ltd, African Energy Academy Ltd, and African Peace Magazine UK, and continues its mandate as a premier forum shaping investment flows, innovation pathways, and policy direction across Africa's energy, oil, and gas sectors.

Scheduled to hold in Qatar, a global hub for energy diplomacy, LNG leadership, and international finance, IAEOGS 2026 will bring together over 1,000 delegates, 250 exhibitors, 200 speakers, and participants from 45+ countries, spanning Africa, the Middle East, Europe, Asia, and the Americas.

Summit Focus

IAEOGS Qatar 2026 will address key strategic themes shaping Africa's energy future, including:

- Energy access and power infrastructure development
- Local content and regional value chain integration
- LNG security and gas monetisation
- Decarbonisation pathways for emerging economies
- Hydrogen and ammonia market expansion
- Carbon pricing and climate finance
- Clean energy investment and energy transition strategies

The programme will feature ministerial panels, CEO roundtables, investor-led sessions, policy dialogues, technical presentations, exhibitions, as well as awards ceremonies, curated tours, and a Charity Golf Tournament supporting youth entrepreneurship and skills development.

Supporting AfCFTA and Regional Integration

IAEOGS 2026 is an independent initiative aligned with the objectives of the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA), which seeks to create a unified continental market of over 1.3 billion people with a combined GDP exceeding USD 3.4 trillion.

Despite this potential, intra-African trade remains below 15 percent. The Summit aims to contribute to reversing this trend by promoting cross-border energy projects, regional supply chains, and investment partnerships that strengthen Africa's competitiveness and energy security.

Travel and Participation Information for Delegates

To ensure a seamless and premium experience, participants are advised to note the following:

Visa and Entry Requirements

Delegates should confirm visa requirements for entry into Qatar well in advance.

Official invitation letters will be issued upon request to support visa applications.

Passports should be valid for at least six (6) months from the date of entry.

Early reservations are strongly recommended due to high demand.

Flights and Transfers

The primary entry point is Hamad International Airport (DOH), Doha.

Airport transfers will be arranged for VIP delegates, speakers, and sponsors.

Registration will open a day prior to the Summit.

Dedicated shuttle services will operate between official hotels and the Summit venue.
